

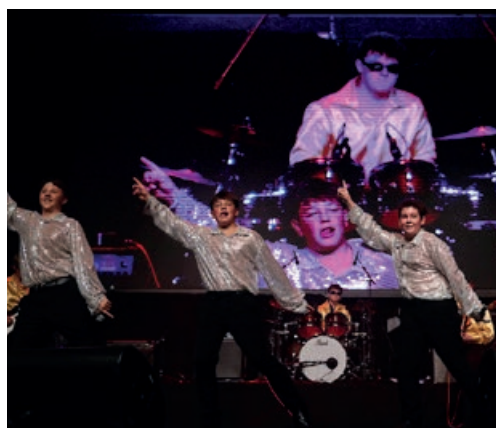

Our e-learning programme is founded on the premise of 1:1 student possession and use of an iPad for their learning.

All our domestic students, from Year 9 to Year 13, use iPads arranged through our iPad lease programme. Their academic courses are accessible online, enabling them to keep up-to-date with their coursework at any time and from anywhere. Schoolbox

The King's College Schoolbox is an online tool that allows parents/guardians to view a wide range of information regarding their son/daughter's daily life at the College.

It enables parents/guardians to access details on their son/daughter's academic and pastoral progress, their timetable, and contact information for teaching staff. It also includes an absence form for notifying the College if your child will be away.

A unique username and password will be emailed to parents/guardians shortly before the start of Term 1.

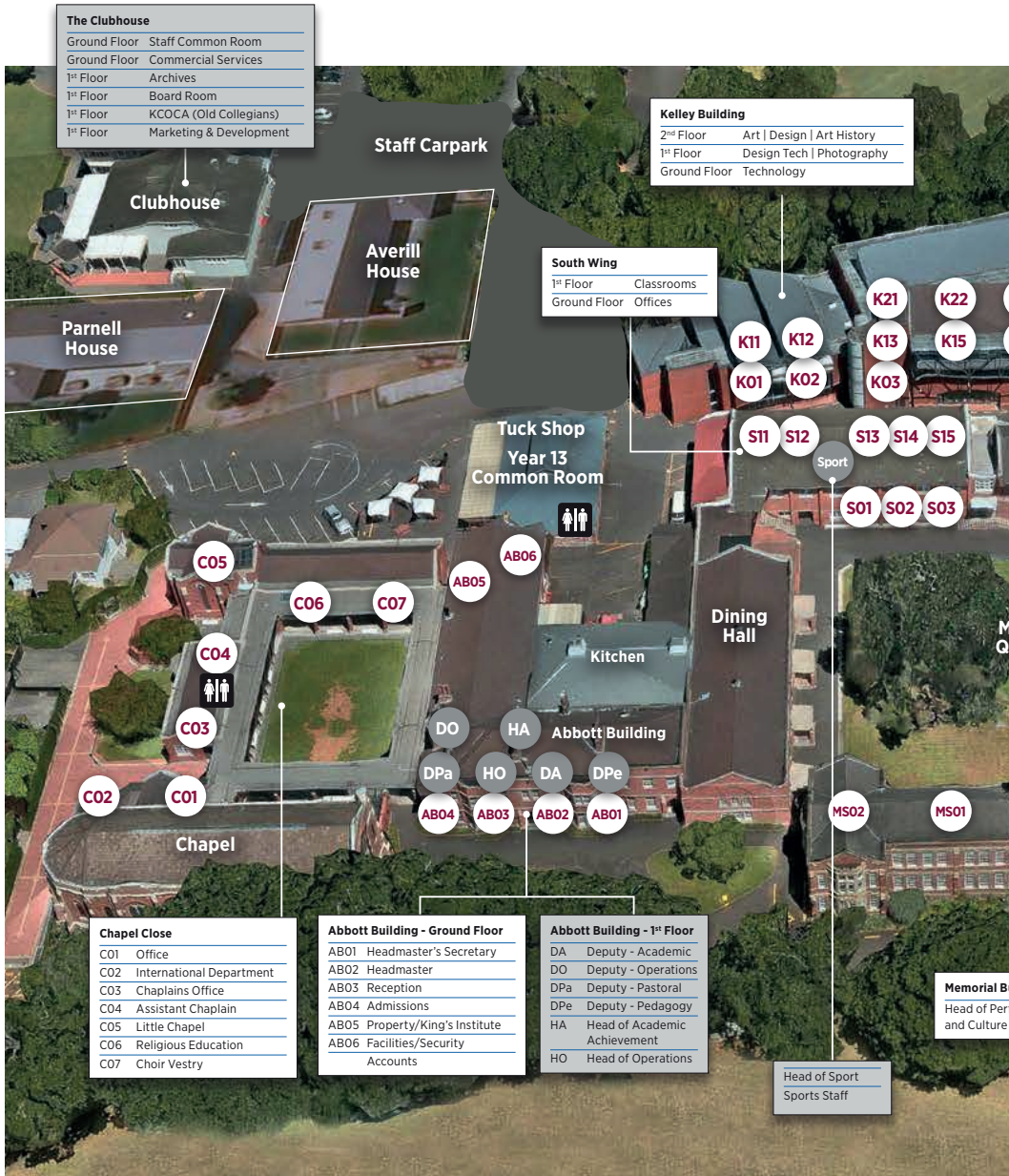

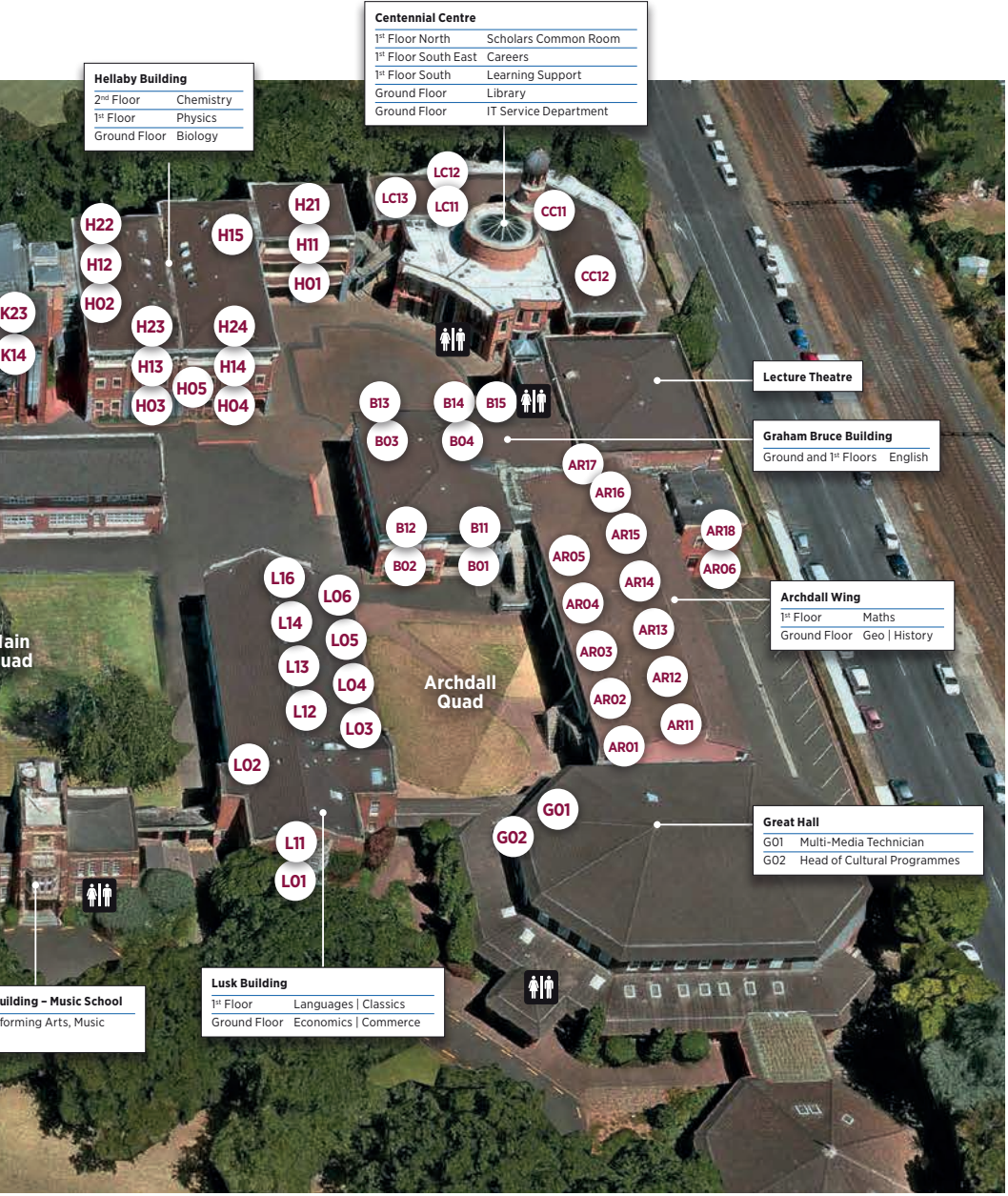
